### SNOW ORDINANCE

With the snow season approaching, the City of Sergeant Bluff reminds everyone of the snow ordinances in Sgt. Bluff. Ordinance 69.10 (1) which states that: No person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or city owned off-street parking within 48 hours after a snow fall of 2 inches or more. Ordinance 69.10 (2) deals with larger snow events. When major storms are foreseen the Mayor, Mayor Pro-tem, City Administrator or City Clerk may declare a snow emergency which requires all vehicles to be removed from the street immediately. The snow emergency remains in effect until the streets have been cleared following the snow event.

Enforcement action will remain for both sections until the streets have been cleared from curb to curb. Please allow crews to clear snow from curb to curb before parking on the street. You must wait until the crews have had time to come back and clear the street completely, this may take multiple passes. Temporarily parking in your yard or other areas of your property during the snow event will be allowed during the snow events. The police department and city snow removal crew's thank you in advance for your cooperation. Help us keep our streets clear and safe through the snow season.
