RECYCLING CHANGES

The company that the City of Sergeant Bluff contracts with to collect recyclables, Gill Hauling, will no longer accept glass in their containers. Beginning with the second Recycle Day in December (15th), **Gill Hauling will not pick up containers that contain glass**. They will not come back to pick up those containers later so it is important that you ensure that no glass is in your container upon their first attempt.

PROTECT YOUR MAILBOX

Protect your mailbox from being mistakenly damaged by a snow plow during this winter season. The Public Works Department recommends that your mailbox adhere to the USPS guidelines for mailboxes.

- Position your mailbox 41" to 45" above ground level.
- Place your mailbox 6" to 8" back from the curb. If you do not have a raised curb, contact your local postmaster for guidance.

SIDEWALK SNOW

City ordinance requires property owners to remove snow, ice, and accumulations promptly from the entire public sidewalk abutting their property. If a property owner does not remove these within a reasonable time (24 hours) the City may remove the accumulations and charge the customer for the cost. Please see Ordinance 136.03 for details.
