WATER RATE INCREASE

New water rates are now in effect and are reflected in this current bill. The basic service charge has increased from \$10.00 per month to \$15.00 per month and the usage charge has changed from \$4.55 for each 1,000 gallons of water to \$4.78 for each 1,000 gallons (Ord 653).
