

## NEW FIREWORKS ORDINANCE

The City of Sergeant Bluff has passed Ordinance 662 which will permit the discharge of fireworks three days prior to July 4<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 4:30 PM until 10:00 pm and up until midnight on July 4<sup>th</sup>. Other regulations include:

- No person under 18 shall possess or discharge consumer fireworks without parental supervision.
- You may only discharge consumer fireworks on property that you own or on property where you have received written consent.
- Discharge of consumer fireworks is NOT PERMITTED in public parks, on city property, on public roadways, streets or alleys.
- Consumer fireworks may not be possessed or discharged while intoxicated or under the influence of drugs or narcotics.
- Those who discharge consumer fireworks assume all responsibility for their operation and the consequences of using them.
- No person may discharge consumer fireworks in a reckless manner that may cause death, injury, fire or property damage.
- No person may discharge consumer fireworks outside of the previously mentioned times and dates.
- Sky lantern open flame devices are not permitted to be released within city limits, except if tethered by a retrievable rope by the person who has control over the device.
- Organizations may apply for a permit to display fireworks.



Other state and local laws may apply. It is the responsibility of every resident who participates in the discharge of fireworks to ensure that they are in compliance of the law. ## NO GRASS CLIPPINGS IN STREET

When you cut or mow your grass, please ensure that you correctly dispose of the grass clippings. It is unlawful to push grass and yard debris into the street (Ch. 135.03). Pushing your grass and other yard debris into the street may clog the storm sewer. It is free for residents to utilize the compost site to dispose of yard waste. You can obtain a Compost Site pass at City Hall for no charge.

## LOST GARBAGE CARTS

Please help yourself and your neighbor by keeping track of your garbage cart. Each garbage cart has a unique number that is assigned to the owner's property. If you see that a cart has been moved by weather or other circumstances, please do your best to return it to the correct address. You may call City Hall at 712-943-4244 and we will help you determine where the cart belongs.
