Mayor Petersen called the meeting to order.

Present: Kollbaum, Wood, Seward, Huser, Wendel.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence observed.

Motion by Wood, seconded by Huser to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

Committee meeting with Consultant, Skip Meisner. Skip furnished the ads for the ICMA and Iowa League of Cities. Discussion. Skip will return tomorrow morning to help place the ads.

Budget presentation. Mike Massey reviewed the fire department's budget line items and answered questions. Other funds reviewed were Landfill/garbage, Library, Storm Water, and questions were answered by Mark Huntley.

Policy decision on South Lewis Blvd. Motion by Kollbaum, seconded by Wendel not to construct three lanes from the city limits to 8th Street at this time, but possibly from 8th to 1st Street. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Seward, seconded by Kollbaum to have Veenstra & Kimm, Chris Jens, conduct a water system study to compare costs with a regional water plant vs. a city water plant. Motion carried 5-0.
